

Description: 2 story framed dwelling facing south with 5 bay entrance facade. Entrance has sidelight and transom and is surrounded by frame with Greek Revival affinities. 2 story tiered porch is supported on slim chamfered posts and entered from street at lower level on W. side. Eaves cornice with wide overhang and deep frieze.

Historical Data: Date uncertain but vaguely Italianate style and Greek Revival overtones make construction just before the Civil War (say, circa 1860) possible though not certain.




