

SPANISH MOSS TRAIL

Trail Corridor, Trailhead and Street Intersection Potential Task List

Adoptive parents are encouraged to perform the following tasks:

1. Litter Control
 - a. Remove all paper, bottles, plastics, etc. from within sight of trail.
 - b. Call 843-525-7054 if trash receptacles require emptying or are damaged.
2. Vegetative Debris Removal
 - a. Remove fallen limbs and low hanging branches from trail corridor; throw into woods where possible.
 - b. Remove pine straw and leaves from trail when feasible.
 - c. Call the City at 843-525-7054 if larger trees and limbs are obstructing trail.
3. Landscaping
 - a. Water newly planted trees and shrubs as needed.
 - b. Deadhead blooming flowers in fall.
 - c. Fertilize flowers/shrubs/ornamental trees.
 - d. Weed beds; spread mulch in beds; plant annuals/perennials.
 - e. Report dead or missing landscape elements.
4. Miscellaneous
 - a. Wipe down signs, benches, trash receptacles, and bike racks.
 - b. Clean graffiti from furnishings/trail.
 - c. Report any problems to the City by calling 843-525-7011.
 - d. Act as "ambassadors" to all who visit the Spanish Moss Trail.
