SBA Business Recovery Center in Beaufort County, South Carolina Now Closed on Saturdays

ATLANTA – The U.S. Small Business Administration (SBA) announced today the Business Recovery Center (BRC) in Beaufort County will be closed on Saturdays but remains open Monday through Friday, to help businesses impacted by Hurricane Matthew that began on Oct. 4, 2016.

The SBA offers low-interest, long-terms disaster loans for physical damage and working capital. To be considered for this assistance, survivors need to apply by the deadline.

The filing deadline to return applications for physical property damage is **Dec. 13, 2016**. The deadline to return economic injury applications is **July 12, 2017**.
