Boundary Street update: Beaufort-Jasper utility to temporarily shut off water near Outback Steakhouse late Monday night

Some Boundary Street-area businesses will be without water late Monday night April 4 while crews work on water lines beneath the roadway as part of the 1.2-mile improvement project.

Although the Beaufort-Jasper Water & Sewer Authority crew will be working Sunday afternoon on the project, the actual water shutdown will be April 4 from approximately 10 p.m. until Tuesday, April 5, around 5 a.m. in the area of the Outback Steakhouse.

The water utility already informed the affected businesses and property owners of the temporary water shutoff. The shutdown is needed to let crews install additional valves in the water system to reduce future shutdowns and minimize the impacts throughout the construction project.

The project runs from Neil Road to Greenlawn Drive and will be completed in phases, starting at the realigned intersection at Robert Smalls Parkway. The work of moving utility lines underground into a duct bank will extend along Boundary from Neil Road to Ribaut Road.

When completed, Boundary Street will remain a four-lane roadway but will feature improved intersections with traffic signals; left-turn lanes; and landscaped middle median; and sidewalks and pathways for pedestrians.
