Parts of First Street to be closed to through-traffic for utilities and roadwork

As part of the Boundary Street improvement project, parts of First Street will be closed to through-traffic starting Monday, May 9, until further notice.

Signs will be posted at the affected intersections behind Chick-fil-A and Walgreens, and also near West View Street, Center View Street and Hogarth Street. The road closings will allow for local traffic to access the 13 houses on that section of First Street and the Boundary Street businesses.

During the initial stages of work, utilities will be relocating existing lines and crews will begin to install the “duct bank” to carry overhead utilities underground. Moving electricity and communications cables off overhead poles and into underground ducts is a major part of the Boundary Street project.

As that work progresses on First Street, additional work will begin to improve stormwater drainage.

“These limited road closures to through-traffic shouldn’t impact most drivers, and we will continue to let local residents to carefully use the road during construction,” Beaufort City Manager Bill Prokop said.
