## **Detour ends early at Boundary Street**

Construction crews finished work earlier than expected and the detour around part of Boundary Street ended Sunday afternoon.

That's good news to Monday morning commuters, including people headed from Beaufort and Lady's Island to work at the Marine Corps Air Station. The closure and short detour had been expected to last until 8 p.m. Monday.

The closure, in front of the Burger King and Dunkin' Donuts, allowed workers to complete storm water drainage and water line work beneath Boundary Street.

The detour routed motorists along Robert Smalls Parkway and Parris Island Gateway. Local traffic still could access most of the businesses clustered near the Robert Smalls Parkway and Boundary Street intersection.

"Our contractor, Beaufort-Jasper Water & Sewer Authority and their teams did a great job getting this work done in a timely manner, especially considering the heat conditions," said Sammy Negron, program manager consultant for the Boundary Street project.
