Water line work to shift traffic Wednesday night at Boundary Street and Robert Smalls Parkway

Late Wednesday night Sept. 7, water line work on Boundary Street will require a partial lane closure, but the traffic change isn't expected to last past sunrise Thursday, Sept. 8.

Beaufort-Jasper Water & Sewer Authority needs to connect a 20-inch water main to a 16-inch line on the western side of the new intersection of Boundary Street and Robert Smalls Parkway.

The work is scheduled to start at 10 p.m. Wednesday and take about six hours, according to Sammy Negron, project manager consultant for the City of Beaufort.

Drivers should use extra caution throughout the intersection during the water line work.

“We are coordinating a lot of different utilities and workers on this project,” Negron said. “There is still much work to complete at the new intersection, and this water line work is essential. There is still paving work to be done across the entire project, including the intersection, so even though it's open, it isn't complete.”

Crews expect to complete the utility work by 5 a.m. or sooner Thursday.

The Boundary Street Improvement Project is a joint effort among the city, county, SC Department of Transportation and Federal Highway Administration.
