

A special meeting of the Beaufort City Council was held on June 5, 2001 at 4:00 p.m. in the City Hall Conference Room at 302 Carteret Street. In attendance were Mayor Bill Rauch, Mayor Pro Tem Donnie Ann Beer, Councilmen Frank Glover, Billy Keyserling, and City Manager John F. McDonough. Councilman Gary B. Fordham was absent. In accordance with South Carolina Code of Laws, 1976, Section 30-4-80(d), as amended, all local media were duly notified of the time, date, place and agenda of this meeting.

The purpose of the meeting was to receive a legal briefing on pending litigation regarding Oxford Ridge.

CALL TO ORDER

The Mayor called the meeting to order at 4:10 p.m.

EXECUTIVE SESSION

On motion by Councilman Keyserling, second by Councilman Glover, Council voted to move into executive session for a legal briefing.

OPEN SESSION

Upon returning to Open Session at 4:25 p.m., Councilman Glover made a motion to adopt the Resolution authorizing the City's attorneys to waive the attorney client privilege in connection with the cases of Oxford Ridge vs. the City and Horizon Development vs. the City.. Councilwoman Beer gave second. The motion passed unanimously. (Copy of Resolution at end of these minutes.)

On motion by Councilman Keyserling, second by Councilwoman Beer, Council voted to go into Executive Session for the discussion of possible litigation regarding a property owner in Spanish Point.
