 - iii. Members noted that they had seen herbicide being sprayed on the plants on Boundary Street, also a trailer full of plants that have been pulled up. The board wanted to know if those plants may have been killed by the herbicide.
 - iv. would like to know what selective herbicides Public Works is using, and why they removed plants along Boundary Street
 - v. Members would like to know why plant material has been removed, and if it will be replaced by drought-tolerant, native plants, as was in the original plan for plants on Boundary Street.

- vi. PTAC respectfully requests to be informed before any other plant material is removed, and of any other plant material that will replace it or what has already been removed.
- d. Members request that Linda Roper come to the next PTAC meeting for questions about missing plant material in the downtown park.
- e. The committee would like to know if there is irrigation at the tree farm.
- f. The committee suggests that PTAC could make a site visit to Southside Park with the Public Works director and the parks supervisor.
- g. PTAC has asked staff to see about a tree planting plan originally presented to the board by Brian Franklin.
 - i. No plans were found
- h. City staff invited Ms. Nagid for general questions.
