

Capital Improvement Program FAQs

Q. What is the CIP?

A. The CIP is the City of Beaufort's [Capital Improvements Program](#) for planning and implementing capital improvements within the City. This includes projects like new parks and pathways, roadway improvements, and improvements to City facilities and equipment.

Q. Who decides what projects are part of the CIP?

A. The program follows a 10-year plan adopted as part of the [City of Beaufort's Comprehensive Plan](#) and then the yearly [strategic planning](#) and [budgeting process](#).

Q. What are the project categories?

A. Each of our projects or programs are categorized into one of nine categories:

- Streetscapes
- Parks
- Trail
- Fleet
- Facilities
- Other Infrastructure
- Roadways
- Stormwater
- Streetscapes and Stormwater

We use the categories to keep track of similar projects for budgeting and for making decisions about the CIP.
